A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY GIVING NOTICE AND CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California a General Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the election of Municipal Officers; and

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS **FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Suisun City, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing: two Members of the City Council for the full term of four-years; a City Clerk for the full term of four years; and a City Treasurer for the full term of four years.

SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to coordinate with the County of Solano Registrar of Voters to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4. That the polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to Election Code Section 10242, except as provided in Sections 14212, 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall **SECTION 5.** be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and SECTION 6. the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form, and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7. That in the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the Solano County Registrar, the City Council, in accordance with Section 15651(a) of the Elections Code, shall set a date and time and place and summon the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear and will determine the tie by lot.
