



1 B. Printing

2 1. The City Clerk shall estimate the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing  
3 the candidates statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result  
4 of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and require each candidate  
5 filing a statement to pay in advance to the local agency their estimated pro rata share of  
6 printing costs as a condition of having their statement included in the voters pamphlet. In  
7 the event the estimated payment is required, the estimate is just an approximation of the  
8 actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly more  
9 or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements.  
10 Accordingly, the clerk is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the  
11 candidates for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final  
12 actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the clerk may require the candidates to pay the  
13 balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the clerk shall prorate the excess  
14 amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within 30 days of the  
15 election.

- 11 a. The candidates at the time of filing their candidate statement shall be required to pay  
12 for the cost of printing, handling, and mailing their candidate statement of  
13 qualifications in English in the main voter pamphlet in the amount of \$288.88.
- 14 b. The candidates at the time of filing their candidate statement shall be required to pay  
15 for the estimated cost of printing, handling, and mailing their candidate statement of  
16 qualifications in Spanish in the main voter pamphlet in the amount of \$338.88.
- 17 c. The candidate at the time of filing their candidate statement shall be required to pay  
18 for the estimated cost of printing, handling, and mailing their candidates statement of  
19 qualifications in Tagalog in the main voter pamphlet in the amount of \$338.88.

18 **SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL MATERIALS PROHIBITED**

19 No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the voter information  
20 guide.

21 **SECTION 5. COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION**

22 That the City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy  
23 of this Resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.

24 **SECTION 6. PREVIOUS RESOLUTIONS REPEALED**


25 That all previous resolutions establishing Council policy on payment for candidates'  
26 statements are repealed.

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**SECTION 7. NOVEMBER 5, 2024 ELECTION**

That this Resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on November 5, 2024 and shall then be repealed.
